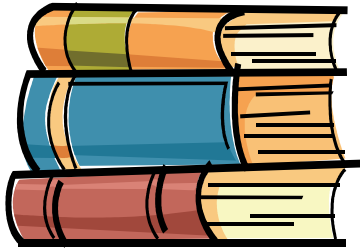


Reading Group History
